THE LEGACY OF JULIA SMITH

Home Health & Hospice, formerly known as Volunteer Nurse Association, traces its roots back to 1906 when Julia Smith led a small group of women to travel door to door providing home health care to the community. They hired their first nurse in 1907 who made 85 home visits within her first month

With the support of the community and donors, the VNA grew steadily in order to meet the needs of the community. Over the course of the century, VNA expanded service to all of Chittenden and Grand Isle Counties and added birth programs, rehabilitation, Adult Day Services, and Hospice care to create a comprehensive home health care service for the full life cycle.

Because of the foresight of Julia Smith and community philanthropists who supported her goal of providing care to all who turn to us in their time of need, family-centered health care was born in our region. We honor her legacy by honoring those who continue to make the same commitment in their legacy giving to this day.
