However, William became a successful banker, and by 1925, he had donated \$100,000 to build the original hospital in his hometown. After his passing his wife, Esther, contributed another substantial gift that allowed for the construction of the Nurses' Quarters which encouraged the development of professional nursing care at Porter. Their daughter, Helen Porter, gave generously throughout her life to support the hospital and provided through her will a substantial bequest. The Helen Porter Rehabilitation and Nursing Facility is named in honor of her incredible generosity.

Because of the gifts of William, Esther, and Helen Porter, high-quality professional healthcare was born in Middlebury, Vermont, and we honor their legacy by honoring those who continue to make the same commitment in their legacy giving to this day.
